Can YOU answer all these questions correctly? Have fun!

1. (Sun, 22 Jan.) Did Peter know it was Jesus walking on the water? What's the key word?
2. (Mon, 23 Jan.) The story of the Syro-Phoenician woman is about faith and healing as much as it is an object lesson for the disciples. What was Jesus trying to teach his disciples through his exchange with the woman?
3. (Tue, 24 Jan.) Joseph brought his sons, Ephraim and Manasseh, to see his father. Jacob angered his son Joseph by doing what?
4. (Wed, 25 Jan.) Jesus commends Peter for his insight into Jesus' identity – "You are the Christ. The Son of the Living God." Yet, a few sentences later, Jesus compares Peter to Satan. Why?
5. (Thur, 26 Jan.) Why did Moses flee to Midian?
6. (Fri, 27 Jan.) What is Jesus' four-step plan for resolving conflicts?
7. (Sat, 28 Jan) What happened when Pharaoh's sorcerers and wise men replicated Aaron's feat with the stake (actually, God's sign)?
